Safaris

savannah, sleep in the wild in a luxury open air 'star-bed', or take a refreshing dip in a natural rock pool as elephant herds pass in the distance.

Other facilities include a swimming pool, massage and treatment rooms, sauna and jacuzzi, a well-equipped gym, and badminton and volleyball courts.

The highlight at Voi Wildlife Lodge is a game observation terrace with a spectacular vantage over the watering hole, twenty-four hours a day.
